

### Art/DT

This term we will be creating our very own African animal mask. We will be using Paper Mache to create a lion face mask. We will be using inspiration from other African sculptures to create our own piece.



### Science

This term we will continue to look at materials and their properties. We will be focussing on wood, plastic, glass, petrol and researching different inventors such as John Dunlop, John McAdam and Charles Macintosh.

### Computing

This term we will be developing our basic painting skills in a painting application on a computer and tablet device. Children will use a simple painting program to paint with different colours and brushes, create shapes, fill areas, undo and redo and add text.

### Geography

This term we will be continuing our comparative study with England and Kenya and where it is situated on the globe. We will also be studying the land use around Kenya locating other countries nearby. We will also be going on a trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park to develop our learning around African animals and the habitats in which some live in.

### English

We will be using Dangle as inspiration for our English this half term. We will be: discussing dilemmas and writing our responses; looking at the features of, and writing our own persuasive letter; practicing our editing skills; using drama to tell a story and finally writing our own poem which we will perform.

### PE
