

### Nursery Phonics

Nursery will be taking part in 'Rhyme Time' following out Little Wandle phonics scheme. We will be learning the nursery rhymes and listening carefully for the sounds we can hear.

Our Rhymes this term:

1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive

Baa, Baa Black Sheep

Hey Diddle Diddle

Humpty Dumpty

Jack and Jill

Miss Molly has a Dolly

Children will be taking home a sharing book to read together with an adult at home to help grow their love of reading.

### Reception Phonics

Reception will be following our Little Wandle phonics programme.

During the Autumn term we will be focusing on Phase 3 phonics. We will be learning the sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, l, ff, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, s, sh, th, ng, nk, i

Children will be bringing home a sharing book and a wordless book to practise their sound pronunciation.

### Literacy

In Literacy children will take part in 'Drawing Club'. Each week we will focus on a text and draw and label the picture. We will build up to writing full sentence using capital letters and full stops.
