# Uniform Policy

This policy has been written following consultation with a section of the whole school community including staff, pupils, parents and governors.

All children attending Walkeringham Primary School are asked to come to school wearing the uniform as listed below. Sweatshirts, cardigans, polo shirts and P.E. kit with or without the school logo on. Items with the school logo are available to buy from Uniform Direct in Gainsborough, or from their website. Items without the school logo on are available to buy from all supermarket clothing chains.

### **Winter Uniform**

- Grey trousers, skirts or pinafore dresses,
- Navy blue sweatshirt, jumper, slip over or cardigan,
- White or pale blue 'polo' type shirt, shirt or blouse,
- Sensible shoes or boots (no heels) that support a child's growing foot development so that your child can run and play safely. Ideally these will be in a plain muted colour with no or little logos on.

### **Summer Uniform**

- Grey trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafore dresses,
- Light blue & white checked summer dresses,
- Navy blue sweatshirt, jumper, slip over or cardigan,
- White or pale blue 'polo' type shirt, shirt or blouse,
- Sensible shoes or sandals that support a child's growing foot development so that your child can run and play safely. Ideally these will be in a plain muted colour with no or little logos on.

### **Sports clothes**

- Pale blue or white t-shirt (with or without the school logo) and plain navy or royal blue shorts,
- Plain navy blue hooded sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan and navy tracksuit bottoms or leggings,
- Trainers that support a child's growing foot development so that your child can run and play safely. Ideally these will be in a plain muted colour with no or little logos on.
- Football boots, shin pads worn with long socks. If boots have metal studs these will need to be checked with the teacher/coach prior to the lesson and going onto the pitch to ensure there are no sharp edges.
- Trunks or one-piece swimming costumes should be worn for swimming. Baggy swimming shorts or bikinis are not permitted by the swimming instructors. Goggles are only allowed if a permission slip has been completed (please ask at the office or download from the school website).

### **Hair and personal appearance**

- Children with long hair must have it tied up at school. Children are asked to come to school with a natural hair colour; dyed or bleached hair is not appropriate. We ask parents to keep styling products, such as gel to an absolute minimum and that any hair style is appropriate to the age of the child.
- Children must not wear makeup or coloured nail varnish for school. Items such as lip balm must be colourless,
- Children may not come to school with hair extensions or false/acrylic/gel nails. Nail length must be in line with the tip of the fingers. Short hair must not have tram-lines cut into it.

- The wearing of jewellery is not permitted except for simple studs or wrist watches.
- All items must be removed during games, swimming and other physical activities. Children who wear studs must be able to remove them by themselves. Please note that we cannot take responsibility for any jewellery or activity tracking devices brought to school.

### **General**

- Mobile phones and electronic devices are not allowed in classrooms or on the playground/school field. If they are brought into school by prior arrangement they **MUST** be stored securely in the school office and collected at the end of the day,
- Children are not allowed to wear clothes that have slogans, text or pictures that could cause offence or make other children feel excluded.
