

History

In History this term we will answer the question: Why was Ancient Egypt's civilisation ahead of its time?

We will ask and answer the following questions to help us to find out:

- What was happening in Britain when the Ancient Egyptians were at their most powerful?
- How have archaeologists helped us know what happened in Ancient Egypt and elsewhere?
- What do we know about other great civilisations of this time?
- How and why were the Ancient Egyptians influenced by their Gods?
- Why did the powerful Egyptians create a culture of slavery?

Science

We will use a range of scientific skills to answer the question: Why do humans have skeletons and muscles?

Each week we will ask and answer the following questions to help us to find out:

- What do we know about our skeletons?
- What do we know about other creatures' skeletons?
- How do muscles work?
- How do joints work?
- How many types of joints can you name?
- Why is it important to have a balanced diet?
- Why is the digestive system important?
- Do all animals eat the same thing?
- Can you plan a meal that is healthy and nutritious?
- Why is exercise important?

Music

Our music this term will be provided by Music Services. We will be learning to play large string instruments, such as Cellos and create a musical ensemble.

PE

Every Tuesday we will have P.E with the Sports Coach and each Monday we will be focussing on Tag Rugby and Yoga with Mr Scoffield.

P.S.H.E

English

In English, we will base our work on a range of books, including The Ancient Sun King, by Emma Carroll and The Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo.

We will also use non-fiction books about Ancient Egypt and video clips to inspire our writing. Children will read individually, both at home and at school, as well as developing reading skills in whole class guided reading lessons.

They will also use the 'Reading Plus' programme at home and at school every day, to develop fluency and comprehension. Children who need extra support with their phonics and reading will continue with the Little Wandle phonics program. Weekly spelling patterns and rules will be learnt in class, practised at home and tested in school each week. Children will be encouraged to use 'Spelling Shed' to practise spellings. In addition to this, children will be tested regularly on the Common Exception words which can be found on our class page on the website.

By the end of Y6, children need to be able to maintain legibility in joined handwriting when writing at speed, therefore this will be a focus in this first term.

DT

In DT we will research and recreate some of the foods that the Ancient Egyptians ate.

Art

We will research Ancient Egyptian canopic jars and then use clay to recreate a canopic jar of our own.
