

Responsibilities

We all have responsibilities, as outlined below, to ensure that the remote learning works well and all children can continue learning.

School Responsibilities

- Provide daily learning activities for pupils.
- Support the parents in the delivery of the learning.
- Maintain responsibility for child welfare and safeguarding.
- Provide individual learning as needed.
- Pupils have access to technology or provide alternative learning.

Parent Responsibilities

- Ensure children are available to learn each day.
- Report any absences to school.
- Ensure children have equipment to access the learning – report any problems with this to school.
- Ensure E-safety is in place.

Pupil Responsibility

- Be on time to start daily learning.
- Complete all learning tasks to the best of your ability.
- Behave online as you would in school – follow the school rules.
- Tell an adult if you have any problems with learning.
- Keep yourself safe online.

What is Remote Learning?

Remote learning is where a child is completing their school work at home as they are unable to attend school.

Why will Remote Learning be needed?

During the Coronavirus pandemic there may be reasons for a child to stay at home and complete their learning.

These reasons are:

- The child has Covid symptoms and is waiting for test results.
- A family member has tested positive for Covid and the family is isolating.
- The school/class bubble has a positive case and is isolating.
- The whole school is isolating.

If your child is isolating at home for Covid related reasons please inform the school office as soon as possible.

If there is a class bubble or whole school closure, we will inform you and send out the arrangements for your child during the isolation period.

We recognise that some children will require support from adults at home and at the same time we acknowledge the difficulties this can place on families.

Remote Learning at

Walkeringham Primary School

As a school we have planned how your child will continue to learn the school curriculum with some adaptations if they have to remain at home. Your child's work will be loaded onto Teams in assignments. Below outlines the two approaches:-

The first day of remote learning will consist of spellings, reading, times tables and number bonds etc. The second day onwards will be as follows:-

An individual, small number of children are isolating:

- You will be directed to video lessons from the Oak Academy which will be linked to the learning that the other children in school are completing.
- Your child will be set activities to complete linked to these lessons.

In addition to the above if the whole class bubble or school is isolating:

- Your child will login to a live register with their teacher at their allotted time as below:
- Team Backshall – 9.30am
- Team Grylls – 9.15am
- Team Peake – 9.00am

Microsoft Teams

Our remote learning will be also delivered via Microsoft Teams. Please make sure you have downloaded the **Teams app** onto the device you are planning to use. Your child has been given their own login details.



When your child is working on their device please ensure that the correct filters are in place and you are monitoring their internet use.

Free School Meals

If you are eligible for free school meals and your child has to isolate, please contact the school office to arrange a food parcel / voucher to be sent. This will be dependant what the Government offering is at the time.

Attendance

Your child will be expected to login to the live register on a daily basis at their allocated time. Remote provision will last for approximately 3-4hrs per day depending on the age of your child.
