This term we are doing a comparative study with England and Kenya. We will be looking at the climate in Africa, how families live, the location of Africa and animals that live there.

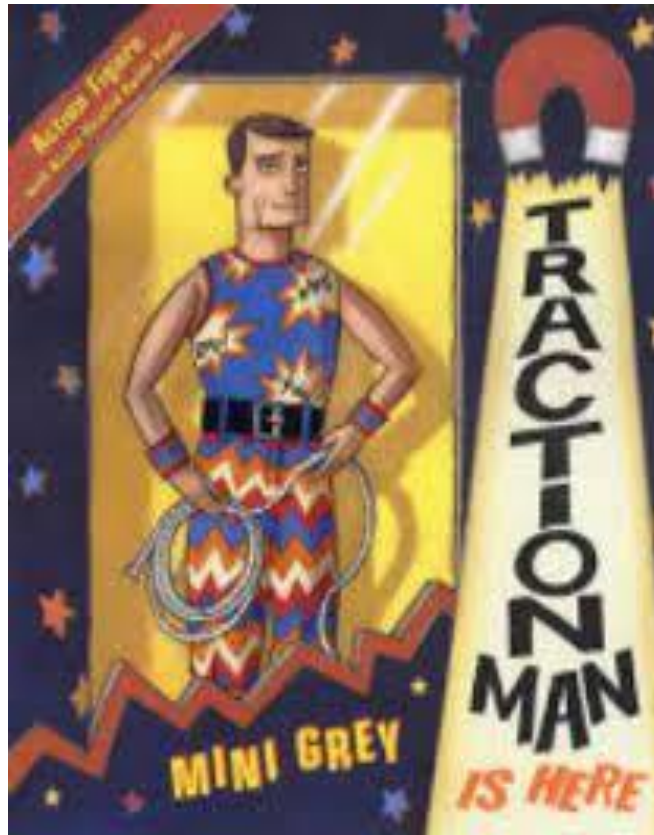
We will also be continuing to extend our vocabulary and geographical language by using our knowledge organisers.
