In the first half-term we will use Excel to learn about spreadsheets and how they can be used to store and manipulate data.

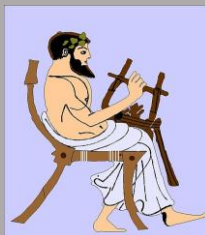
In the second half-term, our unit introduces children to programming with Kodu, a simple visual programming language made specifically for creating games.

Geography

Each week we will answer one of the following learning challenges:

- Where is the Mediterranean?
- Why do Mediterranean countries have a warmer climate than we do?
- Which fruits and vegetables are produced in the Mediterranean?
- What are the advantages/ disadvantages of holidaying in a Mediterranean country?
- Why would you want to visit Athens?

Music

This term we will learn The Dragon Song - a song about kindness, respect, friendship, acceptance and happiness and Stop!, an anti-bullying anthem.

Maths

We will be using White Rose Maths to help us to learn about:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Decimals
- Area, perimeter and volume
- Fractions, decimals and percentages.

English

In English we will be reading 'Who Let the Gods Out' by Maz Evans.

We will write a fact file about Greece, a retelling of the myth, 'Icarus' and a story of our own with a similar warning and consequence.

Weekly spelling patterns and rules will be learnt in class, practised at home and tested in school each week.

We will continue to use Reading Plus, both in school and at home to improve both fluency and comprehension.

We will continue to practise handwriting daily.
